

Registration Examination

Registration Examinations are held once per year. Currently they are held in September.

Generally, the written portion of the Registration Exam is held across Canada, on the second weekend in September and the locations vary depending on the candidates. Written exam sites will be determined annually dependent on candidate locations and numbers.

The practical portion of the Registration Exam is typically held two weeks later at one centralized location.

Examination dates are posted in the OPC online calendar.

Withdrawal Date

If a candidate wishes to withdraw from an exam, OPC must be notified in writing prior to the **exam fee** deadline of July 31. The withdrawal is effective the day it is received by OPC.

Exam fees are not refundable after the Exam Fee deadline. **Exam application fees are not refundable.** Acceptance to sit the exam will be voided if remaining exam fees are not paid by the dates stipulated.

OPC reserves the right to restrict the number of applicants accepted to sit the practical exam due to space and personnel limitations.
