## Residency Program Fee Schedule and Deadlines

Residency Program Application Fee	\$500	Due at time of application
Annual Residency Fee	\$750.13	Due March 31
Annual Associate Member Fee	\$167.17	Due March 31
Typhon System Access Fee	\$100	Paid directly to Typhon

***All fees are subject to applicable taxes based on the Resident's province of residence.***

(ON)	+ 13% HST
(NB/NL/NS/PE)	+ 15% HST

### ***Important Notes***

- The Annual Residency Fee is not due at the time of application to the Residency Program but will be invoiced at the dues renewal the year following acceptance into the Residency Program.
- Residents are considered Associate members; therefore, they must pay both the Annual Residency Fee and the Annual Associate Member Fee, bringing the annual dues total to \$917.30 plus applicable taxes.
- Upon accessing the Typhon Program, you will be prompted to pay a one-time system access fee of \$100.00 USD, which must be paid directly to Typhon (by credit card) prior to use of the program.
- Certified OPC Members who are participating full or part-time in their second discipline Residency will pay Residency fees (\$750.13/\$167.17) plus an additional \$308.62 to maintain their Certification during the time of their training in a second discipline. The entire annual dues amount will be no more than the annual dues of a Certifee. These Members continue to be responsible for fulfillment of the Mandatory Continuing Education requirements for their initial Certification status to remain in good standing.
